

Step-by-Step Guide How to Withdraw Your Child From School with Refund

HOW TO RESIST

1. Go to the FLTJ Resources page to understand your rights. Share all relevant material, so we can push back together!
 - Step-by-step guides, tool kits and templates are available to help us educate one another, know our rights and #RISEUP together. This *has* to be a grassroots movement and cannot rely solely on attorneys, as we are inundated with requests for help. Also the courts are backed up, and judges are not willing to make decisions (and the ones who are issuing decisions are making bad ones).

2. Once you understand your rights, push back with like-minded individuals (vaccinated and unvaccinated) who oppose mandates by following our step-by-step guides.
3. If the school insists on enforcing illegal mandates and putting your child's life and health at risk, consider these ideas:
 - Press criminal charges.
 - a. CA Penal Code Sections 273a (child endangerment), 273d (child abuse - if your child actually gets the jab), and 192b (involuntary manslaughter -if your child dies) can all apply.

- 4. If the school pushes back and will not return your deposit / tuition:
 - Read all enrollment agreements, student handbooks, parent handbooks, Covid19 "return to campus safely" type manuals, policies and procedures.
 - See if there are any terms or provisions that might allow them to mandate new shots.
 - EVEN IF THERE ARE, demand that they refund your money. Remember, the law is on your side.
 - a. A school/district cannot add new shots for in-person learning.
 - b. A school/district cannot mandate an EUA.
 - c. Parents cannot give informed consent to enrolling their child in a clinical trial without
 - KNOWING ALL THE INGREDIENTS in the product - especially the main one!
 - There MUST be a DIRECT BENEFIT to that child SPECIFICALLY where there is "more than minimal risk."
 - DO EVERYTHING AND CONFIRM EVERYTHING IN WRITING. If you meet with them in person or ZOOM or phone call, confirm it all in writing immediately after and close with the following: **"If any of the foregoing does not comport with your understanding of our conversation by phone / ZOOM / in person (choose one) just now, please advise and clarify immediately. Otherwise, I will interpret this email as an accurate summary of our discussion, agreement, and understanding, and will conduct myself accordingly."**
 - If you still get nowhere, you can sue.
 - a. We are NOT taking any new cases at this time.
 - b. Please see our [Attorney Directory](#) for firms that *might* be taking new cases.
 - c. **BEST OPTION: SUE IN SMALL CLAIMS!**

If the amount being sought is less than \$10,000 (or even if it is more but you want to get something back and really prove a point to the school), small claims is the way to go:

- Fast
- Easy with a lot of pro per (self-represented) assistance, and this

- No attorneys allowed (only self-represented / individual parties).

There are many arguments that cut *against* enforcement of any provisions that would allow them to withhold money, but I do not have the time - or enough information - to evaluate them now, and this is the best overview that I can think of at this time. Hopefully it helps!
